OBLIGATED pulled her way to contention along the inside, tracked the pace setting EMPORIA for a half mile, made a quick rail bid in hand to assume command leaving the five sixteenths marker, edged clear into the lane, responded to rousing from the three sixteenths marker and held LISTEN DEAR at bay from the eighth pole home. LISTEN DEAR settled back after an alert break, dropped to the inside near the half mile marker, moved up in hand mid turn, shifted back out and advanced four wide between rivals into the stretch, made a run at the winner in mid stretch, continued willingly but was no match. FUNNY SIDE GIRL, taken to rate off the rail while not far back, moved up five wide outside rivals to make progress entering the stretch, continued with interest to mid stretch then flattened out. BUFFGIRL stalked the pace off the rail, was under pressure four wide into the lane and gave way. SPRING DATE was taken five wide and between rivals nearing the five eighths pole, continued well out in the track for the drive and kept trying to the wire. TANKA hesitated a bit at the break to be away last, moved up between rivals while in hand five furlongs out, stalked the pace in the two path past the three eighths pole, came under pressure mid turn, failed to kick in and weakened in upper stretch. CHANTERELLE lagged back while wide, angled in and had no response. EMPORIA sprinted clear early, set the pace off the rail, allowed the winner through mid turn and faltered. RAFFIAN was done before going a half
