TERMSOFENGAGEMENT was angled in soon after the break and allowed to settle, inched closer nearing the far turn, angled off the inside mid way on the final turn, came five wide for the drive, rallied under pressure to collar ROMAN INVASION near the sixteenth pole, edged clear seventy yards out and held sway. FORGOTTEN KNOT , unhurried early, came under pressure leaving the three eighths pole, swung out six wide for the drive, found his best too late but did manage to get up for the place. ROMAN INVASION , five wide into the backstretch while forwardly placed, challenged three wide under rating around the far turn, dueled past the three eighths pole, edged clear near mid stretch, met the bid of the winner a sixteenth out then gave way grudgingly. BID TIL INCLUDED saved ground while in range, angled out after six furlongs but failed to put in a solid late run. EARLY STAR prompted the early pace in the four path, lodged a two wide bid between rivals around the far turn, briefly poked a head in front, dueled inside ROMAN INVASION into the stretch, chased that one to mid stretch then faded. SOUTHERN RAINBOW cleared early, set the pace in the three path, dropped to the rail when collared around the far turn, dueled briefly then tired nearing the quarter pole.
