VIRGINIA COLONY cleared early, controlled the pace, widened while off the rail into the stretch, responded to strong handling and dug in to prevail. TAPIT EXPRESS, brushed at the start, settled while saving ground, angled out picking up momentum leaving the far turn, advanced four wide between rivals into the stretch, altered further out continuing a run past the sixteenth pole and finished gamely. BIG DUTCH eased off the inside entering the backstretch, chased three wide, was under a solid ride nearing the lane and kept on willingly between horses. MEMPHIS SUNRISE saved ground, quickly gained near the half mile pole, chased the winner into and through the stretch and stayed on with interest. CACAWAY settled off the early pace, raced three wide leaving the far turn, angled to the rail, steadied briefly in upper stretch then closed the gap. AVILORD broke a step slow then steadied, was unhurried for five furlongs, angled out and had some belated action. NO DELAY, taken to rate early, came under pressure leaving the far turn, angled out and came up empty. LE TROUBADOUR, wide chasing the pace, faded nearing the lane then steadied when in close in upper stretch. IRUNALATTE lost ground four wide and weakened. PAUPER'S QUEEN broke outward, lagged back saving ground and never menaced.
