DELAWARE TOWNSHIP was content to trail off of a rapid pace, commenced a rally leaving the three furlong marker, circled five wide into the stretch, surged to command a sixteenth out then drew clear under a drive. EARLY FLYER raced between rivals into the turn, came four wide for the drive, finished willingly between foes and gained the place. XTRA HEAT set a rapid pace inside under pressure, briefly went clear inside the eighth pole then gave way grudgingly. KONA GOLD raced four wide most of the trip and failed to respond. SAY FLORIDA SANDY was a bit fractious in the gate, broke a bit flat footed, saved ground throughout and lacked some room in deep stretch. CALLER ONE broke on top, was pushed along pressing the pace outside of XTRA HEAT, remained a presence to the eighth pole then weakened. BOOTS ON SUNDAY raced three wide between rivals into the turn then tired after three and a half furlongs.
