SILENT VALAY quickly went clear, controlled the pace along the inside, opened a large lead in midstretch and won under mild hand pressure. TOOKIN DOWN saved ground, stalked the pace and gained the place. PROUD OWNER raced three wide on the far turn and lacked the necessary late effort. SALUTELOOT raced wide around the far turn and failed to rally. COMPLETE NUMBER stalked the pace two wide and dropped back. CRAFTY TOAST saved ground and gave way. THE UNFORGIVEN stumbled leaving the starting gate and trailed. .
