YES HE DID , in range four wide, was put to strong urging mid turn, rallied five wide into the stretch, forged ahead approaching the sixteenth marker and pulled away under a drive. FLASHY BULLET , hustled along while off the rail, entered the lane three wide, shifted out advancing past the sixteenth marker and finished well to get the place late. DISTINCTLY DONOVAN was sent up inside and went clear leaving the five eighths pole, was joined approaching the quarter pole, dueled into the lane and stayed on well to get the show. FIELD ARTILLERY , away alertly, was rated just off of DISTINCTLY DONOVAN, engaged that rival leaving the five sixteenths marker, gained a slim advantage entering the stretch, moved away a bit near mid stretch then faded in the final yards. SHISHA saved ground, came under pressure around the turn, shifted out past the sixteenth marker and found his best too late. HOWARD THE AVIATOR broke a step slow, recovered and advanced under rating inside to reach contention, stalked the pace to the head of the lane then failed to respond when asked. WHIRLWIND AFFAIR was outrun. TRIPPIN WITH TAY , three wide between rivals, chased to mid turn and faltered.
