Footnotes

GOLD CASING moved up between rivals early while under rating to stalk the pace, measured the leaders three wide mid turn, easily advanced to command into the stretch, opened up under confident handling in mid stretch and maintained a comfortable advantage while well within himself. ALLERGEES stalked the pace while saving ground, swung out four wide nearing the five sixteenths marker, continued on willingly and managed to save the place. MY CRUSADER broke slowly, settled back early, commenced a five wide run leaving the three eighths pole, came six wide for the drive and flattened out late. NINIAN stalked the pace three wide, failed to respond when called upon and gave way through the lane. CALVIN K disputed the pace inside OUR DIAMOND MINE, held a short lead into the turn, took pressure around the turn, held well to upper stretch then tired in the final three sixteenths. RICHIE'S O KAY failed to menace. OUR DIAMOND MINE battled outside CALVIN K for five and a half furlongs then surrendered.
