Footnotes

CHECKSANDBALANCES saved ground around the turn, was behind a wall of horses entering the stretch, eased out to the five path in upper stretch, closed determinedly and was along in time. WITCH HUNTER chased the pace, slipped through along the rail to gain a clear advantage in midstretch, drifted out late and just missed in a game effort. LEON ROYALE sped to the front, set the pace, raced in the two path entering the stretch and weakened the final furlong. BELLAGIO, bumped and forced in by LET'S DO IT leaving the starting gate, raced wide around the turn, chased the pace to midstretch then gave way. LET'S DO IT bore in leaving the starting gate, chased the pace racing three wide on the turn and gave way in upper stretch. KRATISTO, bumped by BELLAGIO leaving the starting gate, saved ground around the turn and was outrun. SIR DANCE A LOT chased the early pace, raced in the three path leaving the turn and faltered. BIG NOTION, rank between horses near the five eighths pole, dropped back on the turn, drifted wide entering the stretch, was eased and had a bloody mouth cantering to the wire.
