Footnotes

COOPER RIVER , a bit tough to settle into stride while four wide, steadily advanced under mild urging mid turn, forged to command past the three sixteenths marker, briefly edged clear then narrowly prevailed under a strong drive. SHOOKSTOWN ROAD moved up between rivals nearing the five eighths pole, was checked and steadied along from the five furlong marker to the far turn, finally settled three furlongs out, awaited room behind foes approaching the quarter pole, swung out five wide for room in upper stretch, closed gamely under hand urging and just missed. THREE O'CLOCK ROCK prompted the pace three wide, challenged between horses in upper stretch, battled inside the winner past the furlong pole then gave way grudgingly. LOVE TALK , taken to rate, was steadied off the heels of SHOOKSTOWN ROAD entering the lane then failed to generate a strong late kick. ROMAN'S TOUCH cleared early, set the pace two wide, was collared entering the stretch, held well to the furlong marker then faded. TOMORROW'S TALE saved ground under rating, edged closer leaving the five sixteenths pole, failed to sustain and weakened leaving the eighth pole. AE PIT failed to menace while three wide into the lane.
