GIRLSRULETHEWORLD came in leaving the starting gate, hugged the rail entering the stretch and finished willingly. ENGLISH SARAH, in tight quarters leaving the starting gate, saved ground the far turn and passed tired rivals. WHYWHYDELILAH saved ground the far turn, drifted to the two path entering the stretch and weakened. MORAL HIGH GROUND, bumped leaving the starting gate, raced four wide the first turn and was no factor. MISS STAUDER saved ground the first turn and was not a factor. TERLINGUA'S CAUSE bore in leaving the starting gate, sprinted to a clear, early lead, saved ground and faltered. CABALES, bumped and pinched back leaving the starting gate, was outrun. CHEWACLA, outrun, was eased after a half mile.
