DEFY GRAVITY rated in the two path just behind a hotly contested pace, eased out a bit in upper stretch, worked between rivals leaving the eighth pole, collared DANCE TO BRISTOL inside the sixteenth marker, responded to strong handling and forged ahead in the final yards. DANCE TO BRISTOL moved up to the inside of DOE to grab a short lead leaving the five eighths pole, took heavy pressure while off the rail, drifted out a bit wider entering the stretch, shook clear in upper stretch, met the challenge of the winner just past the sixteenth marker, switched to her left lead when crossing over harrow tracks sixty yards out and just failed to last in a very sharp effort. TERRALBA bobbled inward at the break then was allowed to settle while saving ground, edged closer mid turn, angled off the inside in upper stretch, shifted back in leaving the sixteenth pole and finished with good energy. DOE held the early advantage then pressed three wide outside DANCE TO BRISTOL, was floated out a bit wider in upper stretch, held well to the sixteenth marker then faded. BLUEGRASS ATATUDE , hung out four wide prompting the pace, was put to the whip nearing the quarter pole, failed to respond and weakened in the final furlong. DANGEROUS VIXEN , bumped and forced out at the break, lost ground five wide chasing the pace, remained in range to the quarter pole then tired. SENSIBLE LADY bore out bumping ISLAND MEMORIES at the break, chased the pace four wide and dropped back mid turn. ISLAND MEMORIES , bumped at the break, raced between rivals mid turn, angled in and faltered.
