Footnotes

BOPING ALONG accelerated to the front, set the pace near the rail, opened up in midstretch and held sway under urging. FOCUS , unhurried early, was four wide entering the stretch and rallied late. LAIRD ARCHIE prompted the pace outside the winner, his rider dropped his whip near the three sixteenths pole and LAIRD ARCHIE finished gamely despite his rider briefly easing up near the sixteenth pole. GOTTA LOVETHEDRAKE had a shoe fixed in the paddock, raced four wide between horses entering the stretch and rallied mildly. STACK THE CARDS , a forward factor along the rail early, was rated back on the turn then failed to seriously rally. STRAPPED , very wide entering the stretch, passed tired rivals. COLONEL AVARA , very wide turning for home, failed to rally. SANDERS CREEK raced inside horses and weakened. RUN TOMMY RUN , very wide entering the stretch, was outrun. DIXIE SUMMER'S , outrun, swung to the four path in upper stretch. FOOLISH SURPRISE saved ground on the turn and gave way. ANASAZI , very wide entering the stretch, was outrun.
