TWO WHITE ROSES, inside, gained a short lead leaving the far turn, dueled on the turn, edged away in mid stretch and held sway under a drive. BREADKNIFE, five wide to the turn, lodged a three wide bid on the turn, pressed the issue and continued willingly. SHEEZA LOOKER, four wide between rivals early, steadied entering the turn, raced two wide in upper stretch and lasted for the show. PARISHIONER, unhurried early inside, steadied when shut off in upper stretch, angled out near mid stretch and rallied. MINE INNING pressed the early pace four wide between rivals and weakened. TRUISM vied two wide between horses, drifted out in upper stretch and tired. CONQUISTA DORA made a mild rail run on the turn and faltered.
