MALIBU ROCK settled off the rail, moved up into the far turn, lodged a bid to gain a short lead after six furlongs, dueled into the lane, kicked clear in upper stretch and proved best under a drive. GYPSY KING , unhurried early, advanced three wide leaving the far turn, drifted out some entering the lane, continued willingly once straightened and gained the place. WILD IRISH ROGUE , three wide the first turn, stalked the pace two wide past the five eighths pole, moved to challenge nearing the far turn, gained a slim advantage near the three eighths pole, battled inside the winner into the lane then gave way grudgingly the final sixteenth. HISHI SOAR lost ground four wide, gained leaving the far turn, chased the leaders into the lane then faded. GO SWISH saved ground, made a solid rail run into the far turn, steadied in traffic near the three furlong pole, was put to strong drive nearing the quarter pole but failed to respond. CLASS HAPPENING vied inside around the first turn, steadied back entering the backstretch, stalked two wide into the far turn then tired. GO FOR GOLD bobbled at the break and was outrun. TWO A DAYS , three wide to the early lead, angled in down the backstretch, dueled around the far turn and faltered.
