SHE BE CLASSY settled between rivals early, angled out nearing the far turn, rallied five deep past the five sixteenths marker, sustained her run under right handed pressure, drifted in late and just got up. LILY QUATORZE opened up early, set the pace along the inside, increased her lead leaving the five eighths pole, responded when shaken up in upper stretch, finished gamely but just failed to withstand the winner. CELTIC CROSS, three wide between rivals down the backstretch, advanced between foes into the stretch, continued her run to mid stretch then flattened out late. WHO PLAYS BRAHMS saved ground, moved closer leaving the three eighths pole, chased the leader into the lane then came up empty in the final furlong. ALPHA DARLIN, sluggish from the gate, lagged back, came four wide for the drive and had no significant response. FAVORED LADY lost ground four and five wide, made a mild run past the five eighths pole, chased between horses after six furlongs then weakened in the drive. MILFORD BAY, taken to rate, angled towards the inside entering the lane but failed to rally. STRICT ACCESS chased the leader while off the rail, raced between horses mid way on the final turn and tired.
