**Footnotes**

TRIPLE NET lacked speed, hugged the rail, swung outside at the head of the stretch, closed outside HOT HEIR SKIER and was up in time. HOT HEIR SKIER, three deep on the turn, chased the pace, gained the lead in upper stretch and gave way grudgingly. CENTER ON THE MOON circled the turn three wide, floated to the four path entering the stretch and had a slight rally. CUTTY SHARK, swung wide leaving the turn, passed tired horses. DAVE THE USHER showed speed along the rail and gave way in upper stretch. HE'S ACHANCE, wide leaving the turn, was outrun. BUY BUY MISTAKE chased the pace, was two deep on the turn and faltered. WAR READY prompted the pace two wide and stopped after a half mile.
