ONE SOUND CAT broke a bit awkwardly then was taken to rate, angled out near the three eighths pole, steadily gained three wide nearing the lane, forged to command in mid stretch and widened under a drive. UNFLAPPABLE MISS opened up nearing the half mile marker, set a solid pace inside, was collared approaching the eighth pole then stayed on well to save the place. FLYING WILDCAT saved ground, advanced in upper stretch, angled out leaving the furlong marker and hung. SERVE TOO vied early inside the pace setter, chased the issue around the turn, raced between rivals into lane, held well to mid stretch then faded. GAFFNEY'S GRITS saved ground into the lane and failed to respond. EUGENIUS was outrun. BLUE WREN saved ground and was outrun.
