**Footnotes**

ONLY BY INVITATION , unhurried early, was four wide entering the stretch, closed steadily under vigorous rousing and was up in time. D' LIGHTFUL APPEAL chased the pace outside THE REAL PRINCE and finished gamely between horses. THE REAL PRINCE set the pace along the rail and faded in the drive. THUNDER WARRIOR , two wide turning for home, had a mild rally inside horses. ROI DE COEURS , along the rail entering the stretch, eased out in upper stretch and failed to rally between horses. BIG JIM M. , five wide entering the stretch, was not a factor. NO CROSSING LANE saved ground stalking the pace and gave way. AMERICAN STEEL , six wide turning for home, was outrun. FREE AGAIN , outrun, raced along the rail entering the stretch. BENTBUTNOTBROKEN chased the pace three wide and faltered. PRIDE OF SEATTLE was outrun. TAHOE KID unseated his rider when stumbling at the break.
