LAMSTER stalked the pace two wide under rating, lodged a bid between rivals nearing the five sixteenths marker, dueled to mid stretch, edged clear under stout left handed urging approaching the sixteenth marker then prevailed. AMAZIN SUN stalked the pace while saving ground, was put to a ride around the final turn, angled out approaching the stretch, shifted out five to six wide past the eighth pole and closed gamely between rivals. HAM AND ERNIE , four wide the first turn, gained ground mid way on the final turn, swung out six to seven wide in the drive and closed steadily. DANCING DIGITS , taken to rate off the rail, advanced three wide leaving the far turn, moved to even terms past the five sixteenths marker, dueled to mid stretch and faded in the final yards. OUR REVENGE lagged far back, saved ground into the lane and had a belated gain. FRISKIE J rushed four wide into the first turn to go clear, angled in and set a rated pace, was joined after six furlongs, battled past the three sixteenths marker then faded. OLYMPIC CHIEF was outrun.
