PRIME MISTRESS , jostled at the break, lagged back early, angled out and was put to a ride near the three eighths pole, circled five wide advancing into the stretch, drifted in some continuing her run under left handed pressure, took over near the sixteenth marker, dueled outside GAGNE and held that one at bay. GAGNE rated inside, edged closer in upper stretch, eased out and bid between rivals with a sixteenth to go, battled gamely inside the winner and just missed. SLICK PHILLY set a pressured pace inside, shook clear in upper stretch, was confronted nearing the sixteenth pole and faded. FREDERICKA LA ROSE disputed the pace two to three wide outside SLICK PHILLY and gave way in the final sixteenth. POLITYPRECOCCIOUS stalked the contested pace, eased out three wide entering the turn, chased under a ride around the turn, failed to seriously kick in and gradually gave way in the last eighth of a mile. CEE'S FAST bore out sharply at the break, was corrected and settled off the rail, made some four wide progress nearing the quarter pole, failed to sustain in the lane and drifted out late. OUR SILVER CROWN came in at the break making solid contact with the winner and failed to menace.
