### Footnotes

SMILING JORDAN settled nicely while saving ground, angled three wide when moving forward mid turn, edged closer behind a wall of horses in upper stretch, swung out five wide leaving the eighth pole, closed determinedly under strong handling and forged to command late. AWESOME MICH stalked the pace three wide, steadied off heels in mid stretch, shifted in towards the rail, moved to a slim lead inside the sixteenth marker, finished gamely but wasn't quite good enough. BUBBLING SPRINGS prompted the pace while saving ground, moved clear with five furlongs remaining, increased his lead past the half mile marker, drifted out when roused left handed in mid stretch and bothered AWESOME MICH, was straightened away and gave way grudgingly. JAX MAXX settled early saving some ground, angled out mid turn when commencing his run, rolled up five wide into the stretch, continued his run to mid stretch then flattened out on his left lead. TODAY'S MAN, taken to rate off the rail, gained four wide nearing the lane, chased between rivals in mid stretch then weakened in the final sixteenth. WARRENSBURG, unhurried early, angled five wide in upper stretch and lacked a rally. ALISA'S ENGINEER rushed up to contention, angled in to give chase, raced forwardly to upper stretch and weakened. NORTHWOOD BULLY gained the early lead two to three wide, chased from the far turn and faltered. NINTH CLIENT, well wide, gave way.
