TIME OF THE SWORD hugged the rail around the turn, swung out in upper stretch, closed nicely, lugged in near the sixteenth pole and drew out. EVIL LAD hugged the rail on the turn, swung out leaving the bend and rallied mildly. GOBI GOLD rallied between horses. BEE RAPID , wide around the turn, passed tired horses. VIM sped to the early lead, saved ground setting the pace and gave way late. A P ASSET , between horses on the turn, was not a factor. SAINTS PRESERVE US , three deep into the turn, chased the pace and faltered in midstretch. NEVER THE END chased the pace two wide on the turn and faltered in upper stretch. OENOMAUS circled the turn, floated wide entering the stretch and faltered.
