G G'S BUDDY sprinted to the early lead, raced along the rail in the stretch, remained on his left lead and was kept under pressure. RUNNING GAME , three wide leaving the far turn, angled to the four path in upper stretch and rallied mildly. SARBANES moved up in the three path entering the stretch then failed to sustain his bid. BET THE CAT , bumped by IDEOLOGIST leaving the starting gate, advanced inside horses turning for home then faded in the drive. BAY FEST bore in leaving the starting gate, chased the winner and faltered in mid stretch. STOCKTON BAD BEN saved ground and gave way. IDEOLOGIST was pinched back by BAY FEST after bearing in and bumping BET THE CAT leaving the starting gate, lost ground three wide the first turn and faltered in upper stretch. CITY SKY lost ground on the turns and faltered.
