Footnotes

TOOTS lacked speed, was six wide entering the stretch, lightly steadied behind CHANGING FUNDS near the eighth pole, angled in, closed and got up in time. SOLDIER FIELD circled the turn, floated to the five path entering the stretch and finished gamely to narrowly miss. KNIGHT IN ARMOUR moved up in the three path to take the lead entering the stretch and weakened late. TRAPPIST MONK bore in leaving the starting gate, angled to the four path entering the stretch, drifted in near the eighth pole and finished willingly. CHANGING FUNDS , between horses on the turn, swung very wide in midstretch then flattened out. VOCE DEL LEONE , bumped and pinched back leaving the starting gate, saved ground on the turn and was outrun. CREPE AU SUCRE , bumped and pinched back leaving the starting gate, was not a factor. REVELATOR was outrun. ISSUES AND ANSWERS , bumped soon after the break, dueled two wide to the stretch then faltered. MONEY FOR LOVE , bumped soon after the start, raced inside horses and gave way. MOUNTAIN CLIMBER hugged the rail, dueled to the stretch then stopped.
