BOLD AFFAIR went clear soon after the break, set a rated pace off the rail, increased her advantage entering the stretch, responded when set down past the three sixteenths marker, drifted in when switching to her left lead a sixteenth out and maintained a comfortable margin under a drive. CATCH A THIEF was sent up inside rivals leaving the chute, stalked the winner while saving ground, eased out some, gave willing chase through the lane and saved the place. PLUM saved ground around the turn, was angled out for the drive and closed steadily. ACCESS TO CHARLIE, in mid pack, made some progress between rivals after five and a half furlongs but failed to seriously sustain the drive. BAYONNE lagged back while saving ground, angled out in upper stretch and failed to menace. BALTIMORE BELLE, three wide giving chase, dropped back after six furlongs. MUSIC PLEASE, wide, dropped back.
