Footnotes

HITCHIN' TOTHEMOON , in the four path between horses on the turn, gained the lead in midstretch and edged clear under brisk urging. SILVER SLUGGER , steadied in tight quarters along the rail leaving the backstretch, was steadied when shut off along the rail near the five sixteenths pole, eased out for the drive, lacked room between horses near the sixteenth pole and rallied late. VERIFICADOR , five wide around the turn, chased the pace, bid for the lead in midstretch and weakened late. WIE EIN STEIN , steadied in tight quarters leaving the backstretch, raced in the three path between horses on the turn, was two wide in the stretch, came in and bumped MASABI KING near the eighth pole then weakened. MASABI KING , three wide on the backstretch, came in on two rivals leaving the backstretch, came in on SILVER SLUGGER near the five sixteenths pole, raced along the rail in the stretch and was checked when bumped near the eighth pole. RUNNING FOR OFFICE , checked in tight quarters between horses near the three and a half furlongs pole, was outrun after that. DREAM HOLIDAY , in some traffic near the half mile pole, was outrun.
