Footnotes

TURBO TWEAKED chased the pace, circled horses three wide around the turn, swept to command in upper stretch and was under pressure in the drive. NEW ENGLANDER , steadied in close quarters entering the turn, moved up in the five path leaving the bend then rallied. AMADORABLE disputed the pace outside GOLD ON GOLD and weakened. CAMBRIA QUEEN saved ground on the turn and was not a threat. WILDCAT CODE , checked in tight quarters entering the turn, moved up four wide leaving the turn then gave way late. GOLD ON GOLD saved ground, dueled to midstretch then gave way. MISO GOOD , between horses, chased the pace and gave way. BLUES HEIR hugged the rail and faltered entering the turn.
