DRUNKEN LOVE saved ground setting the pace, drifted out in midstretch and dug in tenaciously under brisk urging. R. BEE ESS , four wide around the turn, challenged the winner in midstretch then hung. QUITE A DUDE saved ground in a forward position and weakened through the stretch. MONTEAGLE , outside horses in the stretch, passed tired ones. STING BOY , outside rivals in the lane, passed tired ones. EMERALD CRESCENT , pinched back leaving the starting gate, was no factor and raced wide turning for home. SKELETON CREW chased the pace three wide and faltered. BALLYMOY , wide entering the stretch, was outrun. WIDE RECEIVER , in the two path between horses, chased the pace and faltered. BUBBER , very wide, was outrun. THREE O'CLOCK ROCK saved ground but was outrun.
