KOH I NOOR nudged up to contention leaving the chute, tracked the leaders off the rail, edged closer four wide nearing the stretch, moved to command three sixteenths out, drifted in going clear soon after then widened under a drive. SANCHISE vied inside on a short lead near the five eighths pole, rated back off of ALONGCAMETHEDEVIL leaving the far turn, angled out into the stretch, battled back between rivals nearing the three sixteenths marker, steadied briefly and altered outside when KOH I NOOR drifted in, drifted out through the final sixteenth and saved the place. SCHIST was hustled up outside to stalk the pace, gave chased three wide into the lane and finished with interest. FORECON bobbled at the break, raced far back for five furlongs then had some belated action mid track. SENOR QUICKIE saved ground off the pace, swung out very wide in the drive and lacked the needed bid. SEAL THE DEAL, taken to rate, made a menacing rail run into the stretch, angled out but failed to sustain his run. ALONGCAMETHEDEVIL vied three wide outside SANCHISE, moved clear leaving the half mile turn, was collared in upper stretch and tired. JAZZ AGE was outrun.
