Footnotes

POLONEZ lacked speed, was four wide leaving the turn, closed outside horses and was along in time. VIVACO , swung to the four path leaving the turn, remained on her left lead, gained the lead inside the sixteenth pole and weakened. SEEKING MILLIE , very wide leaving the turn, passed tired horses. HUM ALONG , two deep turning for home, was not a factor. EXACTANELLI , outrun, was not a factor. HEART AND SEEK showed speed racing slightly off the rail, came out a bit in upper stretch and was steadied to avoid the spill near the sixteenth pole. SARAH'S WHISPER hugged the inner rail and was steadied in close quarters near the sixteenth pole. RIPPIN HOT chased the pace, was three deep leaving the turn and gave way. KOBUK VALLEY circled the turn three deep, sprinted clear entering the stretch, fell near the sixteenth pole, got up and cantered off. There was a stewards' inquiry concerning the spill but no action was taken.
