Footnotes

BULL H chased the pace two wide on the turn, eased out to the three path entering the stretch, altered course outside FLYINGTOBECHILDERS approaching the eighth pole, swept to command between rivals inside the eighth pole then eagerly pulled away under intermittent urging. JUST SAYIN , eased out on the turn, floated to the five path in upper stretch, had aim on the lead in midstretch but was out finished. FLYINGTOBECHILDERS broke slowly, circled the turn three wide, gained a short lead in midstretch and weakened late. THREEANDDONEDAN saved ground, disputed the pace to midstretch then weakened. RELENTLESS MOVE lacked speed, raced along the rail around the turn and in upper stretch, angled to the five path in midstretch and was no menace. OIL RIG disputed the pace two wide and gave way in midstretch. RAVEN'S LUCK bobbled leaving the starting gate, entered the stretch in the five path and was not a factor.
