LING LING QI hugged the rail stalking the pace, eased out to the two path leaving the turn, took the lead outside SPEEDING SPIKE approaching the sixteenth pole and drove clear. BIG BLUE NATION , alertly angled to the inner rail soon after the break, advanced inside horses, swung outside approaching the sixteenth pole and closed gamely. SHIMMY TINJO circled horses, floated to the five path entering the stretch then rallied mildly. BRAVO ROMEO chased the pace outside SPEEING SPIKE, floated to the three path turning for home then faded. SPEEDING SPIKE sped to the early lead, hugged the rail setting the pace and gave way the final sixteenth of a mile. COP A TUDE , outside horses on the turn, chased the pace, was fanned to the four path entering the stretch then gave way. HOUSTON BULL , between horses on the turn, was not a factor. OUT TO CONQUER YOU trailed after breaking slowly.
