COLD STARE, unhurried early, raced wide the far turn, challenged for the lead entering the stretch and drew out late. THE UNFORGIVEN stalked the leader, raced three wide to bid for command inside the winner approaching the stretch and was second best. TOOKIN DOWN saved ground, swung out leaving the far turn and failed to menace. IN DUE TIME bore out entering the first turn, raced three wide the first turn, four wide the far turn and weakened. TOO TOO DIVINE, wide both turns, was no factor. MERENGUE, two wide dueling around the first turn, opened up on the backstretch and surrendered after seven furlongs. FINE WOOD had speed along the rail the first turn and faltered.
