SPIRIT OF GULCH , two wide leaving the turn, swung outside in midstretch, closed and drove clear. SANDBAGIN' LOVER saved ground and disputed the pace in a sharp effort. C STREET , four wide leaving the backstretch, bid for lead entering the stretch, dueled to midstretch then surrendered. STEELIX , wide turning for home, gave way in the drive. SARTO , between horses in upper stretch, weakened. CATOUTTATHEBAG was outrun. WOLF THE CHEMIST raced along the rail and was outrun. JAZZ SEEKER dropped back. COINED FOR SUCCESS faltered along the rail.
