Footnotes

HEAVENSTMURGATROID , unhurried early, circled the turn, floated to the five near the quarter pole, swept to command in upper stretch and pulled away while kept to his business. RUN TO THE SUN saved ground on the turn, angled to the three path near the quarter pole and flattened out inside horses. HOLIDAY BOY , unhurried down the backstretch, eased out to the four path near the quarter pole and gained the show position. PENDULUM stalked the pace, moved up three wide entering the stretch, gained a clear lead near the quarter pole and gave way the final furlong. DURER raced near the rail on the turn, was outrun and passed a pair of tired rivals late. COOL JOE BROWN , sent early, saved ground, dueled and faltered in midstretch. PREVENGE disputed the pace two wide and faltered near the three sixteenths pole.
