Footnotes

SERENADIA stalked the pace, advanced in the two path between horses on the turn, eased out to the three path entering the stretch, took command approaching the eighth pole and prevailed under stout pressure. TODAY'S TREASURE set the pace in the two path, opened a clear advantage entering the turn, lost the lead in midstretch and battled back gamely inside the winner. MARMORA lacked speed, raced wide around the turn and rallied. QUEENAMEINA, between horses on the turn, swung to the five path in upper stretch and passed tired rivals. SIGNOFSPRING moved up four wide leaving the turn to reach a striking position the gave way through the stretch. GIRLS' GETAWAY had speed along the rail, was steadied in tight quarters leaving the backstretch then weakened through the stretch. BETRAYED raced along the rail and was not a factor. SILVER PARTNER prompted the pace three wide and faltered entering the stretch.
