E. Z. PATH rushed up outside horses leaving the backstretch, raced wide around the turn, took command in upper stretch and drew clear under urging. KODIAK SONG, unhurried down the backstretch, raced wide around the turn, remained on his left lead in the stretch and rallied. ALTA BOY disputed the pace three wide and weakened the final furlong. TOMORROW'S TALE saved ground, dueled to midstretch then weakened. CRUISE MORE raced between horses in the stretch and passed tired ones. ALL FOR PEACE dueled two wide between horses and weakened in the stretch. GUYGIDDYUP (IRE), very wide turning for home, was outrun. AFLEET KOPPER broke slowly, saved ground around the turn and gave way. BATON ON FIRE saved ground and gave way.
