THUNDER LORD tracked the early pace three wide under strong rating, moved between foes to join the fray after a half mile, dueled outside A FLEET SPIRIT from there, battled between rivals in upper stretch, responded to left then right handed pressure then edged clear late. A FLEET SPIRIT cleared early two wide then was joined from the inside nearing the three quarter pole, took outside pressure into the turn, dueled inside the winner to deep stretch and stayed on gamely in a very sharp effort. DIEGO BAY stalked the pace, ranged up three to four wide into the lane, challenged past the three sixteenths marker but wasn't quite good enough in the final stages. NINTH CLIENT broke a step slow then rushed up along the inside to force the issue three quarters out, dropped back some around the turn, chased the leaders from there and actually stayed on quite well in the drive. SHAMROGE was shuffled back near the six and a half furlong marker, shifted out some and moved quickly four to five wide to threaten into the turn, chased around the turn but came up empty in the drive. MR. E. failed to menace while saving some ground into the lane. HI HO BAMBINO , four wide for the drive, was no threat. SOLDIER FIELD angled wide for the stretch run but lacked a rally. MORE MAYHEM dropped back early.
