BLACK BLADE prompted the pace in the three path, drew even under urging nearing the three furlong marker, dueled with PHONE THE KING until the quarter pole then drew off nicely under a vigorous drive. P DAY close up while four wide down the backstretch, raced three wide on the turn, advanced between rivals leaving the quarter pole then continued willingly to earn the place. SCATMANDU lost ground racing four to five wide, moved closer approaching the quarter pole then flattened out in the drive. BILLY HAGGARD passed tiring rivals. PHONE THE KING set a pressured pace along the rail, dueled with the winner until the quarter pole then tired. MOUNT DEFIANCE angled to the rail around the first turn, rated close up, angled out into the lane then weakened.
