MILITARY COURAGE , sent to the front, set the pace along the rail, remained on his left lead through the stretch and pulled away under brisk urging. STILL FIGHTING saved ground on the turn, swung outside approaching the eighth pole and rallied. OUR FOOLISH PARKER raced along the rail on the turn, chased the pace and weakened. NEW APPEAL circled the turn and weakened. BAY SUMMER lacked speed and passed tired ones. AREYOUBLUFFING raced in the two path on the turn, chased the pace and gave way. FAT MIKEY was no factor. NO CROSSING LANE , wide, was outrun.
