SLICK VIC saved ground stalking the pace, had ample room inside SUMMER OF SUMMERS through the stretch, closed along the rail and drove clear. THUNDER CHARM , swung very wide entering the backstretch, ranged up in the four path on the far turn, had aim on the lead in upper stretch then flattened out. SUMMER OF SUMMERS sprinted to the early lead, was well off the rail straightening out for the stretch drive and weakened the final furlong. MISTER DISH hugged the rail, swung to the four path in midstretch and had a slight rally. HAM AND ERNIE , swung to the four path leaving the far turn, passed tired horses. HARMONIZER , very wide leaving the far turn, came up empty. ROMAN FROLIC , in the two path between horses, chased the pace and gave way the final furlong. PREACHINTOTHEDEVIL , three wide both turns, faltered.
