WAITED, three wide both turns, drew alongside CONCERTO near the sixteenth pole then hung. ALGAR saved ground, eased out slightly in upper stretch and passed tired ones. EARLY WARNING saved ground disputing the pace and gave way in mid stretch. WARRENPEACE was outrun. TESTING was outrun. TESTAFLY prompted the pace racing in the two path and faltered. FIRM DANCER stopped.
