Footnotes

CHANGING FUNDS , unhurried early, raced wide around the turn, opened a clear lead in midstretch then dueled with THUNDER CHARM in a sharp effort. THUNDER CHARM raced forwardly in the two path, was bumped by WITH PLEASURE in upper stretch and finished gamely inside the winner. BIMINI BAY lacked speed, swung to the four path near the quarter pole and was not a late threat. WITH PLEASURE set the pace along the rail, drifted out and bumped THUNDER CHARM in upper stretch and weakened in the drive. ELLOREE WARRIOR raced along the rail and failed to rally. CATIOLICIA , three wide on the turn, chased the pace and gave way. SCARLET DEPUTY was outrun. OUR CHIEF JUSTICE dropped back. OUR MAN DAN stopped and was eased.
