AWLEYAAA , taken to rate early off of a free running leader, rapidly gained three wide after given her cue three furlongs out, rolled up outside to take over into the lane, quickly widened while shifting in towards the rail in mid stretch then held a comfortable margin under mild hand urging. PHI BETA KAFFA , bumped leaving the gate, saved ground under a light hold, angled out four wide approaching the quarter pole and closed up willingly to gain the place. LIBERTYTOWN LASS chased the pace, angled three to four wide advancing into the stretch then failed to sustain in the final sixteenth. LANGFORD BAY , outrun early, was angled three wide nearing the lane but lacked any significant kick. ATLANTIC ROSE broke slowly, steadied off heels soon after, was taken well wide in the opening furlong, made slight wide progress leaving the far turn then went evenly in the drive. MARTINI opened up early when difficult to rate, set the pace towards the rail, was collared after a half mile, gave little resistance and faltered in the final furlong. LADY ISABELLE broke inward bumping PHI BETA KAFFA and was outrun.
