### Footnotes

FRIENDLY PRINCESS , reluctant to load into the starting gate, saved ground the far turn, found room along the rail through the stretch, took the lead in midstretch and lasted under pressure. B L'S WAGON saved ground stalking the pace under patient handling, eased out three wide mid way on the far turn, bid for the lead outside horses in upper stretch then hung. GO THE DISTANCE , five deep between horses the first turn, moved up between rivals leaving the backstretch, gained a short lead entering the far turn, was two deep turning for home and tired in the stretch. CHOCOLATE DROPS , six deep the first turn, gained a short lead outside rivals leaving the backstretch, drifted wide turning for home and tired. SEASONS CHANGE hugged the inner rail the first turn and was not a factor. FRENCH MISTRESS , wide the first turn, was outrun. DIA MAYO , four deep entering the first turn, was not a factor and raced along the inner rail in the stretch. MORE PUNCH advanced three wide on the first turn to take the lead approaching the backstretch, hugged the rail entering the far turn and faltered approaching the stretch. RICH'S SPITFIRE was outrun. SAFARI chased the early pace two wide and dropped back on the far turn.
