RICH GIRL , four wide, advanced in upper stretch, drifted out a bit late and continued willingly. IN LOVE saved ground, moved a bit closer into the lane, angled out then was outfinished. BACK BAY BEA broke a step slow, settled back after that, angled out five wide in upper stretch, made a run leaving the eighth pole then steadied when floated out. LISTENING FR WINGS saved ground mid turn and failed to respond. TO THE CROWD stalked the pace between rivals and gave way in upper stretch. MISS DUMAINE , away alertly, chased the winner two wide and gave way in upper stretch. RUBY JANES GIRL failed to keep pace and raced four wide in upper stretch.
