Footnotes

QUANTICO QUEEN tracked a contested pace three to four wide, moved to a clear lead after six furlongs, met the challenge of I'VEGOTADATE in mid stretch, drifted in some late but held firm under a drive. I'VEGOTADATE settled off the rail, angled four wide picking up momentum leaving the three eighths pole, ranged up outside the winner in mid stretch but was denied. SARATOGA NOTES vied two wide inside TIANA, took over near the five eighths pole, took pressure leaving the far turn, chased after being headed and stayed on well. MIMI'S SHOES rated in range off the rail, edged closer between rivals leaving the far turn, came under a strong ride into the stretch, chased behind foes in mid stretch but hung. HIT BY A HURRICANE saved ground off the pace, got through along the rail advancing into the lane, loomed in mid stretch then flattened out. WISDOM SEEKER was shuffled back into the first turn, made a mild move past the half mile pole then tired. TEN HAT TRICKS , three to four wide, dropped back. TIANA was used four wide around the first turn to take the early lead, vied three wide outside SARATOGA NOTES past the five eighths pole then stopped exiting the far turn.
