Footnotes

EIGHTTOFASTTOCATCH , eagerly cleared in the opening quarter mile, was nicely rated setting a moderate pace towards the rail, quickly widened when sharply roused three sixteenths out, continued under strong handling to the sixteenth pole then was geared down in the final sixty yards. HELLO LOVER settled off the pace, worked four wide between rivals into the lane, finished with good energy but was no match. CHARGE , fractious in the gate, saved ground off the pace, came under pressure around the turn, continued inside through the drive and kept on well. ALBRECHT , away in good order, prompted the early pace outside the winner, was ridden along mid turn, gave willing chase to mid stretch and weakened. CONCEALED IDENTITY , forward early while saving ground, angled out near the half mile marker, gave chase to the head of the lane and gave way. REGAL SOLO , taken to rate four wide, circled five wide into the stretch and weakened. LONDON LANE , off the rail, gave some early chase and retreated.
