Footnotes

QUEENS PARTNER , taken to rate wide in mid pack, rallied four wide into the lane, took command in upper stretch, lugged in when clear and held sway under a drive. CUTTER moved up between rivals nearing the five eighths pole to stalk the pace, lodged a three wide bid between foes entering the lane and continued gamely. DESTINEDTOBEMINE , taken to rate early, moved up some between rivals mid turn, came three wide for the drive and closed steadily. BELGIAN BEER advanced along the inside nearing the turn, chased the leader while continuing to save ground around the turn then came up empty in the drive. LONDON TOWN , sluggish early, angled five wide into the lane and failed to respond. TEA TOTT saved ground and failed to menace. SHOULD BE DANCIN' was hustled clear early, set the pace two wide, was ridden along around the turn, took pressure nearing the stretch then tired leaving the three sixteenths pole. FIVE STAR GENERAL stalked the pace three wide and faltered nearing the lane.
