Footnotes

DANCE WITH JAMES , patiently handled in the four path early, advanced under rating behind rivals leaving the five sixteenths marker, angled out five wide into the stretch, forged to a clear lead while on her left lead in mid stretch, lugged in and proved best under a drive. WACHACHA , five wide early, moved up outside the winner into the turn, challenged four wide between rivals nearing the stretch, could not match strides through the final three sixteenths but continued on willingly to earn the place. NOTHING HONOR prompted the pace two wide, assumed command past the five sixteenths marker, was collared in upper stretch, faded in the final sixteenth and just held the show. RAGABASH broke a step slow, moved up towards the inside under rating around the turn, steadied when awaiting room in upper stretch, swung out very wide leaving the eighth pole and finished with interest. CAKE WALK , away alertly, forced the pace three wide around the turn, continued to press between rivals to the head of the lane then gave way. SKYPIRATE broke a step slow, was hard used along the inside to take command, took pressure into the turn, dueled briefly mid turn then gave way in upper stretch.
